

DUTIES:

GUIDELINES:

Tulsa Parks looks forward to continuing the Work-to-Swim program for the 2015 pool season.

All parents of Work-to-Swim participants are asked to take an active role in their child's involvement with the program.

We ask that a parent accompany each child at the time of enrollment in the program. This will ensure that each parent is informed and aware of our expectations of their child's participation.

Children (7-15 yr.) may enroll at any City of Tulsa

municipal pool. The pool where the child enrolls is where the child will work and accumulate visits to the pool. The Pool Manager will take enrollment, supervise and document the participants' cleaning activities.

Each participant will receive six free admissions to the pool for three hours of work. The participant *must* work a minimum of 30 minutes before using the Work-to-Swim pass. Each 30 minutes of work completed yields one free visit. Once a participant completes three hours of work he/she may begin working towards another Work-to-Swim pass.

In order for this program to be a success, parent's are to encourage their child to follow through with the agreed upon work commitment.

Tulsa Parks hopes that the Work-to-Swim program will again provide the opportunity for all children to enjoy our pools.
